


MISSION STATEMENT

DO YOU LOVE ME?

Peter is asked three times by Jesus; "Do you love me?"

There's a frustration, we've all felt from time to time, on being asked the same question by someone we love. Maybe it's a parent, husband or wife, suffering from dementia and we are asked the same question repeatedly. Though we've answered, the answer has not sunk in or, if it has, only for a short while.

We struggle to answer again and again what we believe the person already knows and yet, all experts would suggest, the right thing to do is to patiently answer the question.

It's different here of course. Jesus has heard the answer but is, in his own way, reminding Peter that he will have to remind himself many times that he does love Jesus. Such reminders will be needed when Peter's faith is tested, his ways misunderstood and his loyalty may well place his life at risk. In these moments of uncertainty, Peter will need to remind himself repeatedly that his love for Jesus is deeply rooted and sincere and that it is a love that is totally appreciated and reciprocated.

It's our story too of course. In moments of doubt, in those all too frequent moments when our skies darken and become overcast with worry, uncertainty and un-invited pain, we too need to be reminded that our love of Jesus and his for us is the only answer that will help make sense of our situation.

Enumerators will wear high visibility jackets and produce an official Identification Card during the course of their work.
