YEAR OF PRAYER 2014 BALLYMOTE

God has always been big on what is called 'petitionary' prayer. St. Augustine once called petitionary prayer 'our greatest strength and God's greatest weakness'. The Lord assures us 'Ask and you shall receive ... knock and it will be opened to you ... whatever you in my name will be granted you.' Electricity is a tremendous and extraordinary power filtered through the 'power points', the 'electricity outlets' with which we are familiar. It can light a room, heat a home etc only, of course, if we are 'plugged in'. Likewise God is a mysterious and extraordinary power and can filter into our lives in many ways. The power of God, we are assured is ready to lighten our darkness, mend our brokenness, fill our emptiness, brace our courage, straighten our crookedness and create in us hearts of love, but we don't benefit from this awesome power unless we are connected and the connection is prayer. The writer of the psalm assures us 'the Lord is near to all who call upon him' [Psalm 145:18] We are praying for our diocese ... because we want to connect with God whose power can change and transform us and bring a renewal of faith in our diocese.

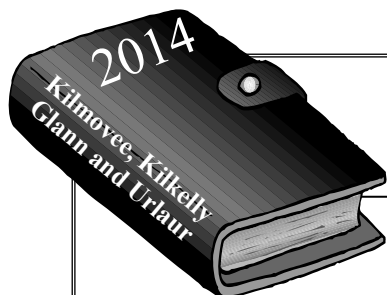
