and lead us not into temptation

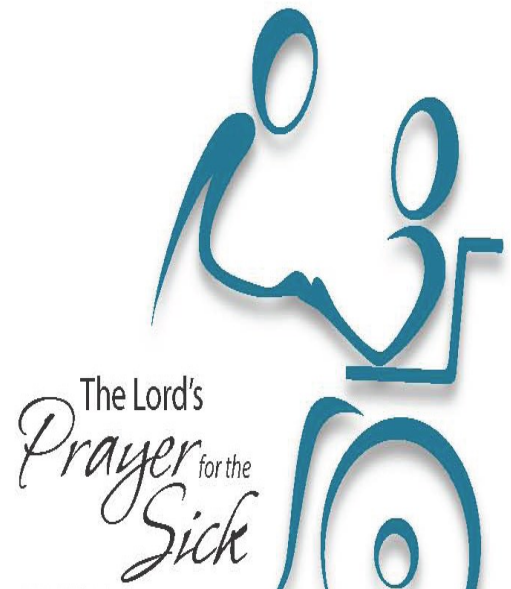
restrain my desire to scream, lash out, accuse, find fault

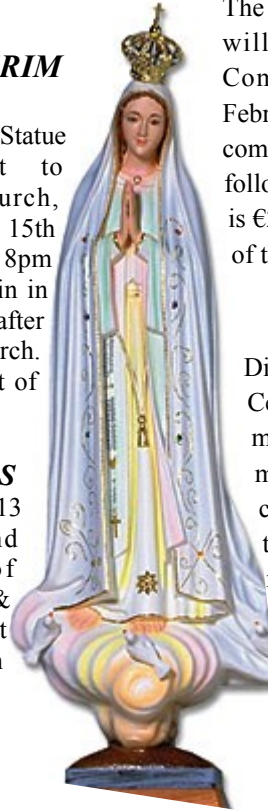

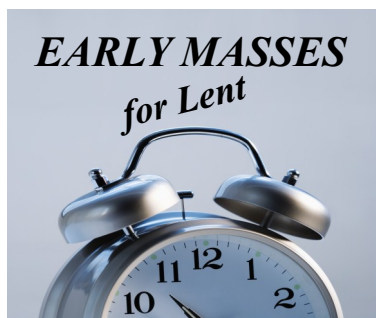


SUPERVISED STUDY
