FROM SARCASM TO AWARENESS

“Why does someone believe you when you say there are four billion stars but check when you say the paint is wet?” (a tweet from @ketekennedy)

Isn't there something in that? Sometimes the more simple the message the more difficult it can be to take in. This weekend's Gospel introduces us to the clever lawyer wanting to embarrass Jesus with a less than sincere question. When Jesus narrows it down to a deepened awareness of our neighbour, the lawyer's thunder is somewhat stolen but he feels the need for another question; “and who is my neighbour?” This leads to the great story being told of the “Good Samaritan”, the one who kept it simple. He saw a man in need, tended to his needs and involved others in helping him.

The questioner becomes the questioned! “Which of the three proved himself a neighbour to the man who had fallen into the brigands' hands?” “The one who took pity on him, I suppose”, replies the lawyer. Jesus assures him the answer is correct. Keep it simple.

“Go yourself and do the same

Now if Jesus had made it complicated, saying that a degree had to be sought, books by the dozen had to be read, miles had to be travelled, languages had to be learned, courses had to be taken, it might seem more believable but no, he just says in his own way “the paint is wet”!

Do we believe him? Are we willing to go ourselves and “do the same”? The truth as well as peace is often found in the simple way of life.

WELL DONE EVERYBODY

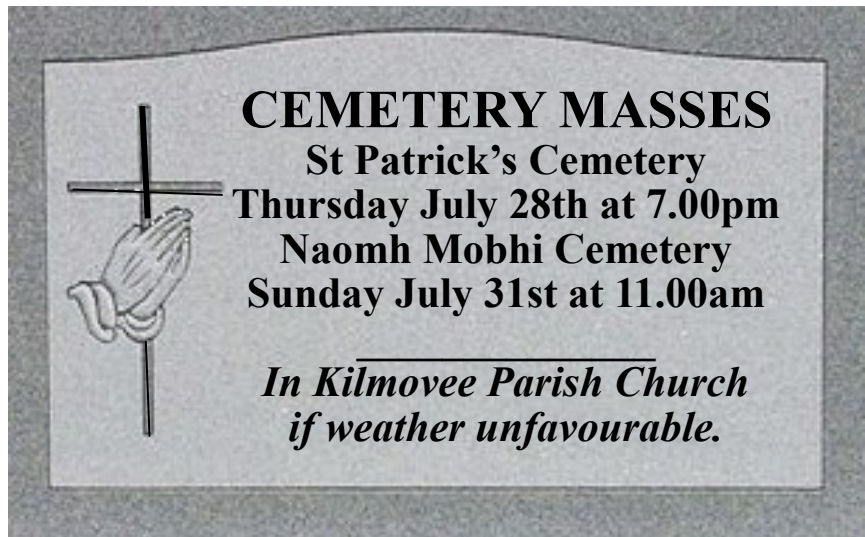
A word of congratulations to all who were involved in the organisation of this week's Seosamh MacGabhann Summer School. It was great to see so many people joining us during the week.

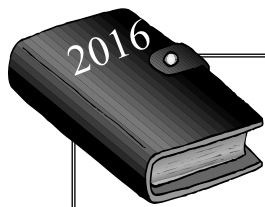
HOSPITAL VISITS
