Kilmovee, a parish in East Mayo, includes four church areas; Kilmovee, Urlaur, Kilkelly and Glann. Each brings its own distinct style and contribution to the Faith Story. Its churches range in age from one of the oldest in the Diocese (St Patrick's, Glann) to the two most recently built (Kilkelly and Urlaur). There exists a strong tradition of faith and an embracing of all things Irish; Traditional Music, GAA, Irish Language (with emphasis on drama) and, central to all a "Céad Mile Fáilte". Urlaur Abbey is the focus of much pride and its Hallowed Ground, welcomes pilgrim and visitor, especially on August 4th for the Annual Pattern. Kilmovee boasts a hugely active and enterprising Community Centre that acts as a hub for much that takes place - from Postal Services to the weekly "eyes down" that is "Community Bingo". Likewise, each of the four areas has its own history, identity and network of activity but we strive to be as one - as Parish - God's People.
