KILMOVEE/URLAUR WATER GROUP

The AGM of Kilmovee/Urlaur group water scheme was held on 6th July in Urlaur Uommunity Centre. At the outset the meeting was adjourned and two minutes silence observed as a mark of respect for Martin Frain RIP who was a Board member for many years and gave outstanding service for the scheme. The minutes of the last AGM were read and adopted. Accounts were presented by the Auditor and adopted. Two Board members retired, Chairperson, Gerry Meehan and Secretary, Alex Mc Donnell. Tributes were paid to both for their commitment over a long period of time. Consumers are advised to check their meters to see if they indicate water is being lost. There should be no movement of the dial when water is not being used. Board members will assist in this regard if requested. Leaking cisterns and overflowing water troughs can cause serious losses. Water rates for 2015 were sanctioned as follows: *

No free domestic allowance. * €1.00 charge per CM3 (Cubic Metre) used. A CM3 is 220 gallons of water. * Flat rate minimum charge of €25.00 per land meter. Usage in excess will be charged at €1.00 per CM3
