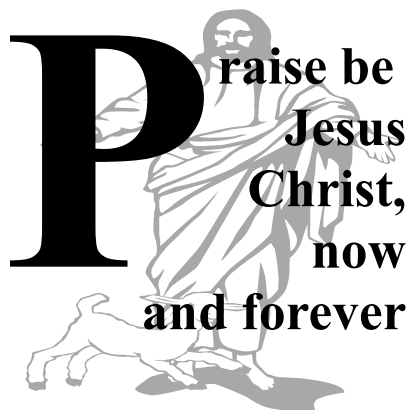


## The Baptism of the Lord—13th January 2013
