BLESSED ARE THE PEACEMAKERS

This photograph taken on January 30th 1972, recalls a violent time in Irish History. It also is a reminder of the power of peace in the midst of this same conflict.

Fr Eddie Daly, walked with his people and through hatred that day as he waved a white handkerchief for peace, that the wounded might be offered assistance and the frightened be led to safety. His courage was certain and his symbolic gesture recognised for what it was. A passage was cleared and it's taken ever since as a given that lives were saved.

A few years later, Fr Eddie became Bishop of Derry and continued to be a voice for peace and stability. Often drawing criticism from his own faithful as well as authorities, he remained confident in the belief that dialogue and peace were possible. He certainly played his part and made a difference. This week he died, aged 82, and received much well deserved praise for a life lived in faith, hope and love - a life faithful to his calling.

There's a thought in here somewhere about what image will be left of us? What one photograph might tell our story and let it be known we tried to make a difference.

HERITAGE DAY

As part of Heritage Week 2016 Kilmovee Community Centre has planned a FREE day of Family Fun looking back at life 100 years ago in

the east Mayo village of Kilmovee. From 1pm to 6pm on Saturday 27th August 2016. Kilmovee community buildings will be transformed to portray life a century ago with a traditional schoolroom, Cailleach "hag" bed, storytelling corner, traditional music, crafts, food, drama, games and much more. Joe Byrne of Midwest Radio will present an illustrated folklore talk. Traditional food will be cooked and served, traditional music will be played throughout the day and Kilmovee's Foróige's Club will be presenting their "Eiri amach na Casca 1916" play as Gaeilge. There will be a mini-cinema showing films of life in rural Ireland a century ago. Prizes will be given in the best fancy dress competition in traditional clothing for under 15 year olds. This will be very much a 'hands-on' experience for all ages and visitors will be encouraged to listen, watch, touch and taste all of the experiences of the day. If anyone has some 1916 memorabilia to loan to the Community Centre this would be very much appreciated. These artefacts will be displayed in the Thatch cottage on the day alongside Mayo County Library's Cumman na mBan Decade of Centenaries Exhibition and GMIT's Heritage Studies Undergraduate Exhibition; 1916: Mayo's Story. CUMANN na mBAN EXHIBITION

Kilmovee Heritage Centre and Cois Tine have a fascinating exhibition on the women who fought for Irish independence on display in the Thatched Cottage. This will be on display Monday - Friday 10am-4pm for July and August. The exhibition, highlights as it says "What did the women do?" through the stories of Cumann na mBan and the role of women in the cultural, literary and ultimately political revival of the decade from 1912 to 1922. It tells the story of Mayo's Kathleen Lynn, one of the most senior officers in the

1916 Rising and Nurse Elizabeth O' Farrell the women who delivered the 1916 surrender with Pearse and shows how the formation of Cumann na mBan was a vital step in the empowerment of women.
