MEN'S HEALTH AND WELLBEING

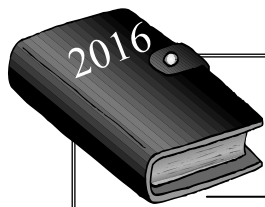
