We are most thankful to the present members of the PPC who have given so freely of their time and energy over the past few years..



We talked a little about the past year and noted some of the highlights for the parish. These included our Memorial Service in November, the Parish Mission, First Holy Communion Days and Confirmation. The decoration of our churches for Lent and Easter as well as at Christmas time was, in many ways, the work of the PPC with the ever reliable generosity and support of so many who help in the day to day life of our parish. The Mass for Examination Students (in Urlaur Church) with its cup of tea was considered a very special gathering. The ministries exercised in the parish were mentioned, Readers, Eucharistic Ministers and in a special way, our choirs. The re-formation of the Choir in Urlaur is a particular joy for us all.

FERS are undertaking a survey for breeding Curlew in Co. Mayo. The optimum means of locating nests is ask the custodians of the landscape - the farmers. When we know where the breeding Curlew are, we will inform the DAFM, and the farms with breeding Curlew on them will be prioritised for entry into the voluntary Agri-Environment Scheme, GLAS. We hope that GLAS will bring an additional income to farmers, to keep both the farmers and the

birds on the land. Your assistance in this regard would be particularly welcome.
