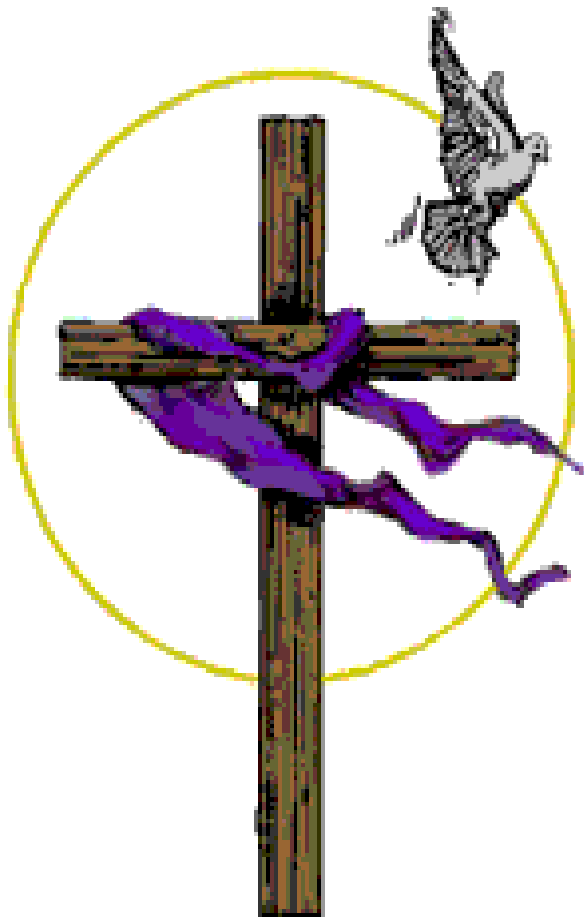

TRIUMPH OF THE CROSS



There are many today who know only too well the weight of the Cross. It is often difficult, if not impossible, to see any “triumph” in its beams or beneath its burden.

Too many are suffering now! I heard recently of a mother in the Middle East. Her daughter was taken captive by misguided people. She pleaded with them, saying she would get money as much money as she could to secure her daughter’s release. She was told the captors did not want her money. They wanted to “break her heart”. Hard to recognise anything approaching triumph in that.

Where then lies the triumph? How then is it found?

Somewhere and somehow the answer is found in the knowledge that no matter how much we suffer, either personally or through the observed suffering of someone we love, the Cross says that Christ has travelled this way before us.
