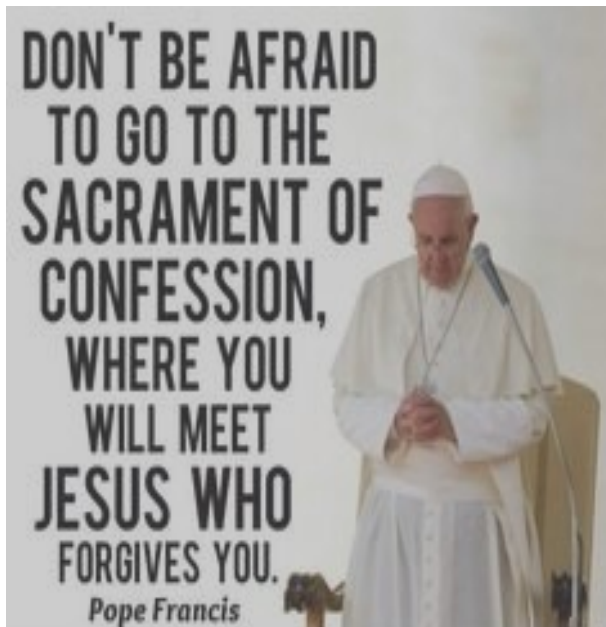

***HAPPY THE MAN - HAPPY THE WOMAN .....***



Whose offence is forgiven!

"Happy the man whose offence is forgiven, whose sin is remitted" - we could very easily miss that line in this weekend's Liturgy.

It is the first line of the Responsorial Psalm. The response is "***You are my refuge, O Lord; you fill me with the joy of salvation***". When have we last felt this joy? The "salvation" spoken of; do we really believe we are in need of it?

Archbishop Joe Cassidy, R.I.P. once spoke of the parish priest in Charlestown speaking at a Mass when Joe was a young man. He said he had reached the conclusion that "there are an awful lot of saints in this parish that God knows nothing about"!! The priest was speaking of confessions and either people not feeling the need to go or else going and saying "I did nothing wrong ....." (I have no sin) - for that to be true, the priest felt, there had to be an "awful lot of saints" in the parish :)

We are sinners! That's reality; and unless we can embrace that truth we may never truly come to value the word of forgiveness or the opportunity of salvation.

Please God, during Lent 2015, we will place renewed focus on this Sacrament in our Parish. Please consider making "Confessions" part of your Lenten journey. We need a few more saints in the parish!!

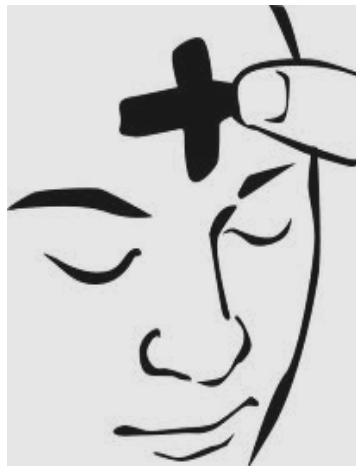
### **GURTEEN CONCERT**
