
MISSION STATEMENT

Trinity Sunday – 15th June 2014



"IT'S A MYSTERY"

Brendan Grace used tell a story about a bishop asking "Bottler" to explain the Trinity. Bottler was nervous and didn't speak very clearly. He said "It's three Divine Persons in the one God". He spoke so unclearly the bishop asked him to repeat and he did. The bishop still couldn't make out what he was saying and said "Young man, I don't understand" to which Bottler replied "You're not supposed to understand - it's a mystery, isn't it?"

There was, of course, no answer to that other than laughter. Bottler had nailed it! The Trinity, at the heart of our faith, remains mystery. We talk of Father, Son and Spirit as if disjointed and, though they express themeslves in different, there is only ONE GOD. Of course it's mystery. The greatest minds may well try to untangle it but the mystery remains. God is Trinity but God is one.

Should we get bogged down in this? Quite likely not. Maybe we should rather be grateful that God allows us so many ways to access His oneness. We can approach him in the brother that is Jesus, the guidance and protection that is Father and the power, so badly needed in our lives, that is Spirit.

I heard a bishop speak at Mass last weekend about the left and right hand of God, about the mind of God and he was saying that, in many ways, this is GOD. The mind is the Father and the two hands the Son and Spirit. One can't function to full capacity without the other and yet it is their oneness that God's power is revealed. He spoke about a horse race and that for there to be a winner three things are needed - a good stable, a good horse and a good jockey. Only when all three work as one can victory be sought after and achieved.

Maybe this has something to say to us also of Trinity. We need to continually call upon and recognise all three for the unity to shine through in our lives.

YEAR OF PRAYER remembering PARISH OF TUBBERCURRY

Tubbercurry/Cloonacool is a parish with a population of 1,700. The Church of St. John, Evangelist was built in 1933 and St. Michael's Church, Cloonacool was built about 1853. There is a Mass Rock at Masshill and Mass is celebrated there each year. Tubbercurry had a Workhouse and each year a Mass is said in the Famine Graveyard at the site in Connolly Park. The Marist Sisters have served the community in education and pastoral care for over 100 years and continue to work in and around the parish. There are two primary schools (Holy Family NS, Tubbercurry and St. Michael's NS, Cloonacool), one Secondary School (St. Attracta's Community School) and a third level college (North Connaught College). Gallagher House Resource Centre caters for peole with special needs. The Chamber of Commerce is active and **Tubbercurry Family Resource Centre** provides many services. There is a strong tradition of music, sport, athletics, drama and other cultural activities. Tubbercurry hosts the oldest Drama Festival in the country each March. In July it hosts the South Sligo Summer School and the Old Fair day in August. The priests of the parish are Fr. Martin Jennings, and Fr. Dan O'Mahony.


BIKE WEEK
