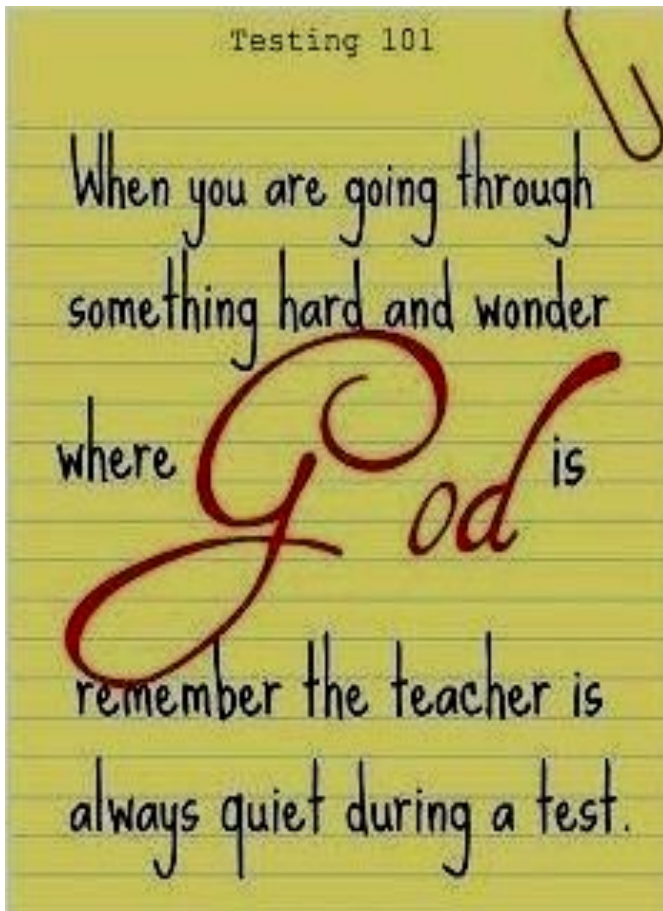


## MISSION STATEMENT
