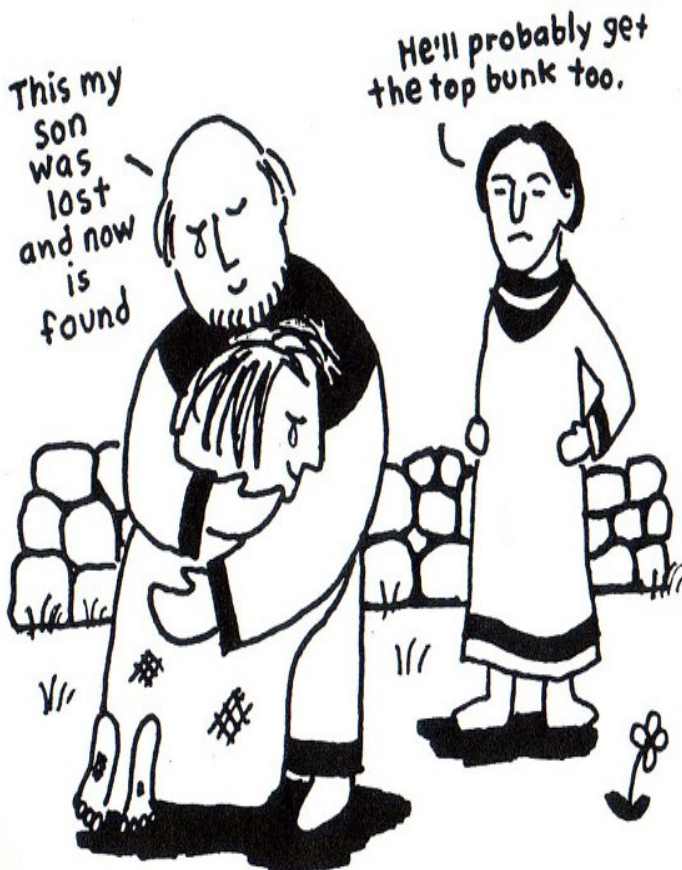


MISSION STATEMENT
