TRAINING PROGRAMME

Commencing September 7th (Charlestown) and the next day, September 8th (Ballyhaunis) South West Mayo is planning a REVIVAL PLUS training programme for Unemployed persons or Unemployed and not on the live register. This project is funded by the Social and Community Activation Programme SICAP. It will include a Level 3 QQI accredited module in Personal Effectiveness and is aimed at supporting individuals taking that first step back to work after a period out of the work force for whatever reason. It is one day per week for six weeks 10am-3pm with complimentary light lunch provided. This project is particularly suitable for the person who may be the dependant on a person's social welfare claim and therefore not eligible for supports directly from Department of Social Protection.
