PARISH OF BOHOLA

The Parish of Bohola is a rural community located about five miles from both Swinford and Kiltimagh. Called after St. Tola, ['Both' = dwelling] it originally had a thatched church which was replaced in 1864 by the present one dedicated to 'The Immaculate Conception & St. Joseph. Celebrations to mark the 150th anniversary are planned for the June bank holiday week-end. The area is blessed with great fishing in the river Moy on whose banks are the impressive remains of a Mass Rock and an ancient burial site at Carragolda. A fine Community centre, evidence of an excellent and energetic community, is named after Martin Sheridan, the famous athlete who won nine gold Olympic medals in the early twentieth century. The O'Dwyer Cheshire Home, built in Lismirrane on the ancestral home of Paul & Bill O'Dwyer, who was Mayor of New York, now cares for the physically handicapped. The six original National Schools were amalgamated in 1986 and now the parish has one central school. The former school at Shraheens is a Mass Centre and caters for a great community.
