IS DAILY MASS FOR YOU?

We are fortunate to have Mass in our Parish practically every day of the week. In fact, most days there are Masses in two of our churches. It is so heartening to see how much this means to the regulars who attend these Masses. We are grateful to you for your flexibility and your understanding if Mass has to be changed or dropped on a given day.

Some of our Masses are listed as Anniversary Masses or Masses for Special Intentions, where maybe someone has asked for prayers for a private intention, perhaps for someone who is sick and on other occasions the Mass might be one of Thanksgiving for a blessing received. All Masses are offered for everybody in attendance and for the intentions of our people. The mention of particular intentions is to call us together to pray around that intention, remember a person or family etc.

It is likely that there are parishioners who might be free to attend Daily Mass but who don't for no other reason than they've not been reminded or invited to come along. Chances are there are more people who could attend Mass during the week. Daily Mass is usually around twenty minutes and it may be a good time to think about joining other parishioners a few times a week to hear together God's Word and receive the Eucharist together.

Know that you are always welcome. It is at the heart of a parish that we pray together and, in our Catholic tradition, Daily Mass is central to that prayer.

CUMMAN na mBAN EXHIBITON

Kilmovee Heritage Centre and Cois Tine have a fascinating exhibition on the women who fought for Irish independence on display in the Thatched Cottage. This will be on display Mon - Friday 10-4pm for July and August and on Sunday 17th, 24th and 31st July after Mass from 10.30 - 11.30am. The exhibition, highlights as it says "What did the women do?" through the stories of Cumann na mBan and the role of women in the cultural, literary and ultimately political revival of the decade from 1912 to 1922. It tells the story of Mayo's Kathleen Lynn, one of the most senior officers in the 1916 Rising and Nurse Elizabeth O'Farrell the women who delivered the 1916 surrender with Pearse and shows how the formation of Cumann na mBan was a vital step in the empowerment of women. 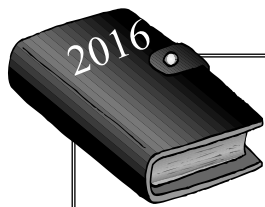
