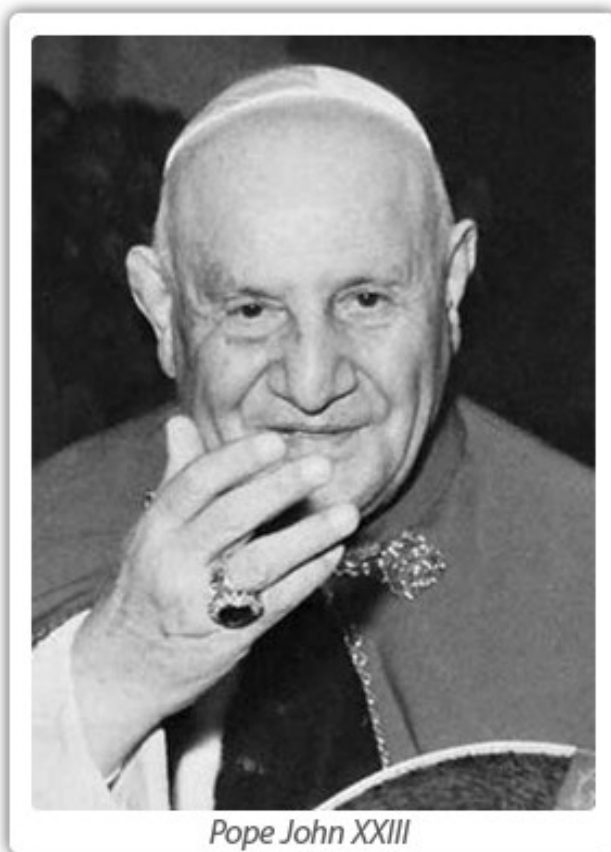


MISSION STATEMENT

Thanks to all who turned out to welcome the "Mary's Meals Walkers" on Wednesday evening. It was a very pleasant gathering with a fine group of people from Donegal and elsewhere breaking their journey on the way to Knock. The main role of Mary's Meals is to support children in poorer countries as they attend school by providing them with a basic lunch each day. This came about in response to a question put to a young child whose father was dead and mother dying of Aids. When asked what he wished for the boy replied that he wished he could go to school and not feel hungry. From that response grew "Mary's Meals" which now feeds over 700000 children every day. The parish of St Eunan's Cathedral in Derry has adopted one school and supports that school every day. A question! Is that something we might consider doing as a parish at some stage?
