YEAR OF PRAYER remembering PARISH OF KILTIMAGH

The Parish of Kiltimagh is situated at the Southern end of the Diocese of Achonry. It is bordered with the Parish of Bohola and Swinford in Achonry Diocese and the Parish of Aughamore, Knock, Claremorris, Mayo Abbey and Balla in the Archdiocese of Tuam. The Parish Church is the Church of The Holy Family and the 125th anniversary of the building of the Church in 1888 was celebrated in 2013. Mass is also celebrated in Craggagh Community Centre every Sunday. The original name of the Parish is Killedan which comes from the Irish 'Cill Liodáin' - the 'Church of Liodáin'. Killedan Abbey, which was a Franciscan foundation, was the centre of Christianity in this part of Co. Mayo from the twelfth to the sixteenth century. The restored stone Church believed to have been built in the twelfth century still stands in the Townland of Killedan and Mass is celebrated there every July. The Church of the Holy Family has a web-cam system in operation - www.kiltimaghparish.org The Parish is served by two priests, Fr. Paddy Kilcoyne is Parish Priest and Fr. Pat Lynch is Priest in Residence
