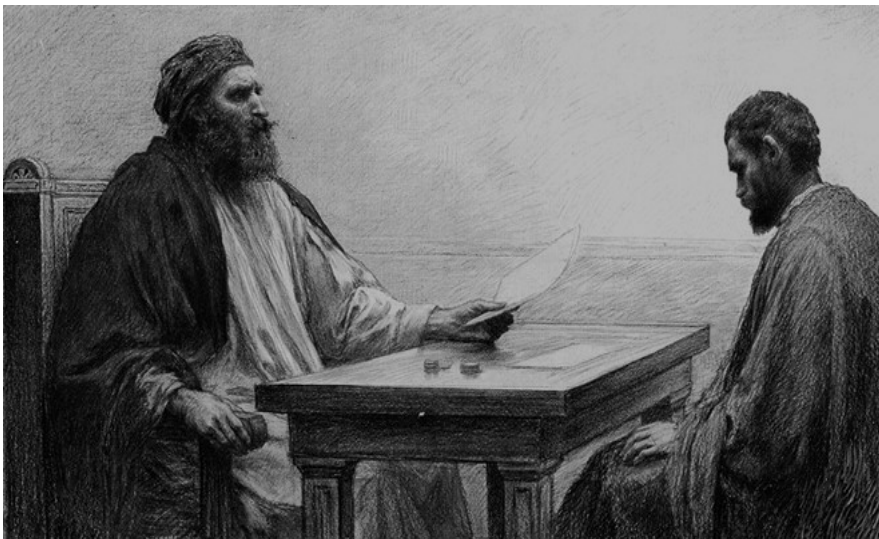
## MISSION STATEMENT

### THE CRAFTY STEWARD

When we were in the seminary one of the students used speak about this parable. He said he'd love to write a "Northern Irish" version of the Scriptures and he imagined the conversation between the steward and the people who owed his employer money.

"Hi, how's about you? How much do you owe?"

"I owe 100".

"Here, sit you down there and write eighty" .....

It's a strange passage in many ways and I suppose at day's end, what the boss noticed was that money he had been owed was now paid, albeit less than might have been owed but quite likely more than he ever thought he'd receive. The "steward" in his craftiness made friends on both sides of the street. Those who owed money felt they'd received something of a "let-off" and the boss felt he had more money than otherwise he might have hoped for or expected.

Somewhere in all of this he realised that his steward had a keen business mind and was able to see where the cards would fall. The employer began to re-assess his judgement of the steward and realised if he could act and think like this when his back was to the wall, he had potential.

We mightn't like him as a person or agree with everything he did but there's something admirable in his ability to read the situation. The employer feels his is due a second chance. Maybe we all deserve that .....

## **SAFEGUARDING**

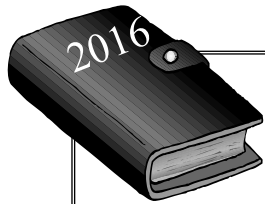
