*They were like sheep
without a Shepherd*

At the end of this month, Fr Brendan McDonagh, who has been a curate in Lisacul (Diocese of Elphin and Parish of Loughglynn) is being transferred to a new parish in the diocese. In recent weeks I've met many people who are genuinely saddened to see him leave. Indeed, he has been a neighbour of my own for the past six years and I too will miss him from the area. There is a true sense of loss, I think it fair to say, felt among the people. They believe they are losing a good friend. Brendan, like all priests, though saddened to leave his community, realises the necessity for this move. There is a need elsewhere in the diocese and the Bishop of Elphin, with fewer priests, is doing his best to meet that need.

Added to the loss felt by our neighbours is the dawning realisation that it is most unlikely Fr Brendan will be replaced. More responsibility will now fall on the Parish Priest and the people of the parish as many of the roles fulfilled to date by Fr Brendan will need attention. The loss of a priest in a community is a-kin to the loss of the Post Office, a local shop or a service people thought would always be there. For the vast majority of people, this loss, is still numbered among the major setbacks to a community.

Jesus, aware in this weekend's Gospel, that the people need a shepherd set himself the task of speaking with the people, being with the people. That need continues. There is an urgent need in our church to hear again the "CALL OF GOD" to serve God and His people through the Ministry of Priesthood. May we hear that call, pray for and encourage vocations.

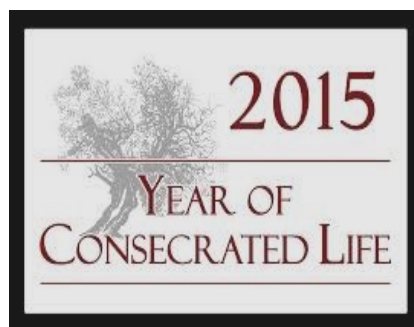
