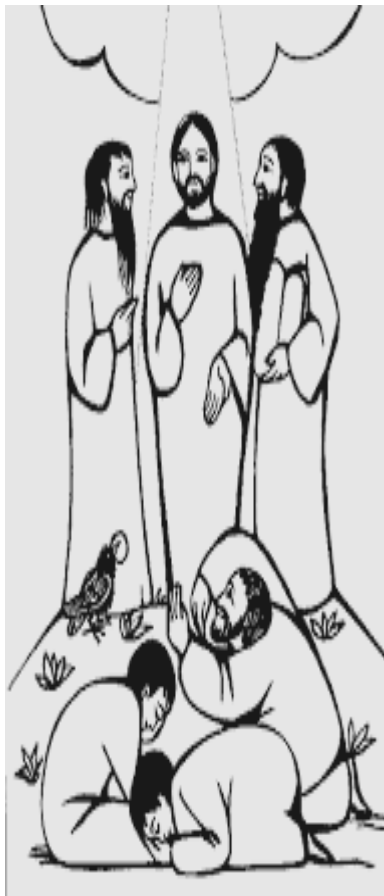


MISSION STATEMENT

In your house water should not be flowing from your toilet cistern into your toilet except when being flushed. Check your water meter which should show no movement if water is not being used. If you require assistance, contact any committee member. If you notice a leak on any line, please contact any committee member. There are some water bills overdue. These must be paid immediately to avoid surcharge of 15%. Water bills for 2014 will be issued in early April.
