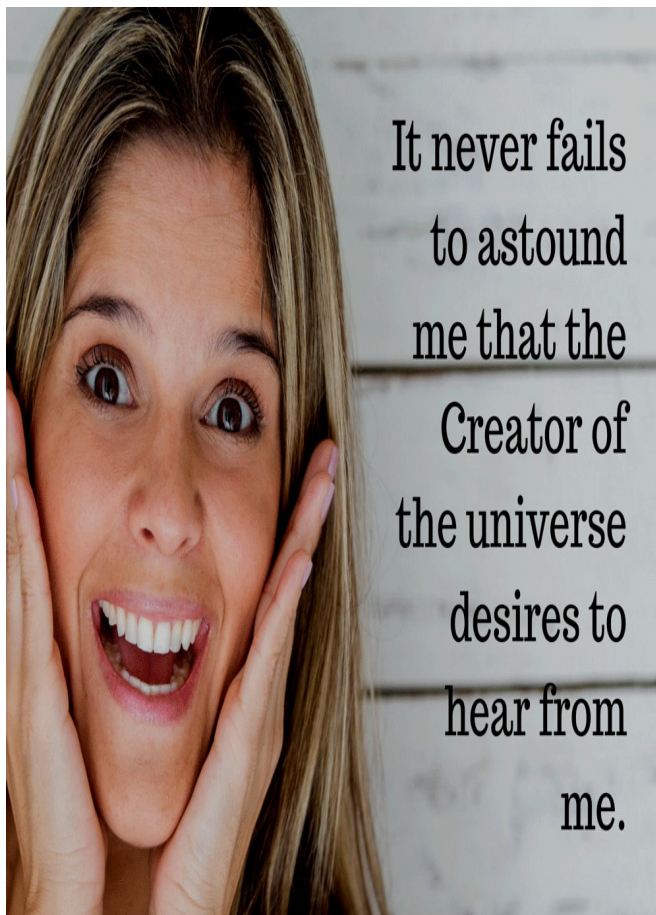
MISSION STATEMENT

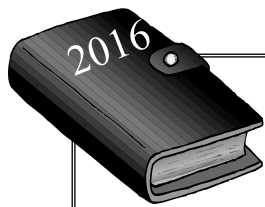
FIRST HOLY COMMUNION
