BISHOP KEVIN DORAN

During this words on Sunday Last, following his ordination as Bishop of Elphin, Bishop Kevin addressed the topic of vocations. Citing our neighbouring parish of Loughglynn, where the Parish Priest died a few weeks ago, (God rest you Fr John O'Rourke, R.I.P.), he said he knew the people of the parish await news of a replacement. He said he hopes there will be an answer in the short term but the long term situation is different. He said he can only have priests to send to parishes if parishes send priests to the diocese. It was a striking comment. He developed the theme by asking the people of Elphin Diocese (around 100,000 of them) to select from each of the six deaneries of the diocese one man to consider becoming a priest and to ask these men to get in touch with him or a member of the Vocations Team. Quite a challenge but a very essential one. Our diocese is also in need of fresh blood and new priests. Do you know anyone that you feel might have a vocation to the priesthood and would you consider making the suggestion to him? Think about it.
