Palm/Passion Sunday - 20th March 2016



THE JOURNEY BEGINS

Gathered this weekend, we begin Holy Week 2016. On this Palm Sunday we carry the Palm in solidarity with Jesus as he enters Jerusalem. We take our place with the crowd that lined the road that far off day and cheered his arrival.

On Thursday next we will celebrate the Chrism Mass in the Cathedral, Ballaghaderreen, where the Holy Oils will be consecrated and blessed and where the priests of the diocese renew their call to commitment in the service of the people and parishes of the diocese. Later that evening we will go again to the “Upper Room” in the celebration of the Mass of The Lord’s Supper in our parish. That evening we will repose the Blessed Sacrament and no Masses will be celebrated in the parish, or in the world, until the Easter Vigil of Holy Saturday.

On Good Friday, we will recall the story of the Lord’s condemnation to death and his journey to Calvary, recalling to the events along the way - the conversion of a thief and the recognition by a soldier of “A son of God”. We will pray too for the intentions of our local and global church, for people of all faiths and none and for peace. If the weather is favourable we are hoping to gather at **URLAUR ABBEY** on **GOOD FRIDAY** evening to pray there, in this **YEAR OF MERCY**, the Stations of The Cross and to Venerate the Cross. *(We will go to the Church if weather not suitable)*

At the Easter Vigil and again on Easter Sunday we will rejoice in the empty tomb and in Jesus’ resurrection from the dead. This is at the very heart of our Faith. “He is risen”.

KILMOVEE SHAMROCKS

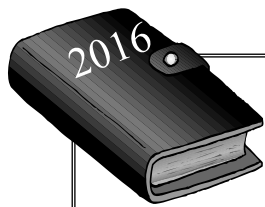
