MIRACLES TAKE MANY SHAPES AND FORMS

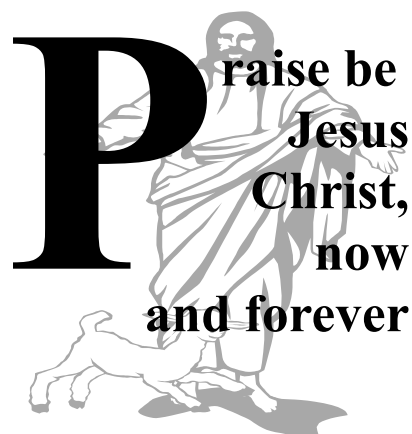
