## MISSION STATEMENT

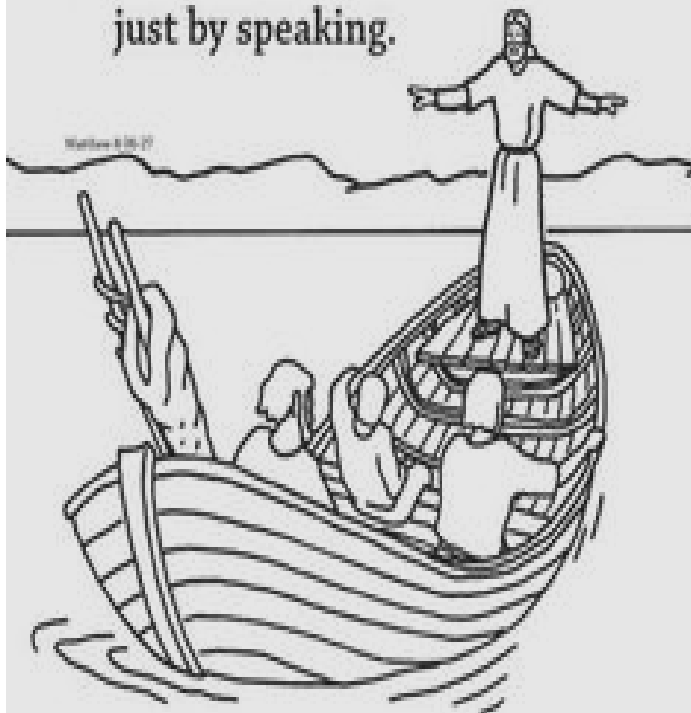

There will be 2 workshops in Kilmovee Community Centre which will be held during the Seosamh Mac Gabhann Summer School week. The first workshop will be at 12 midday until 1pm for adults whilst classes are taking place and parents can stay on for the workshop whilst their children are in class. The second workshop will be at 1pm for children and will take place during the lunch break. The Revival Roadshow is an exciting eco-project which aims to bring upcycling and reuse workshops to communities all over Ireland. The workshops will be interesting, fun and FREE!! Travelling in a retro reused ambulance, the Roadshow will visit towns, villages and festivals the length and breadth of Ireland during the summer of 2015. Our workshops will feature experienced artists and craftspeople sharing their skills to help and encourage people of all ages and skillsets to rescue, rethink, upcycle and reuse items instead of throwing them out. The Revival Roadshow is a CRNI (Community Reuse Network Ireland) project and is funded by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
