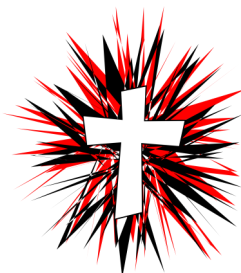
**W**e turn to you, Lord and King
