MEETINGS, WORDS AND A CHANGE OF HEART

Today's meeting between Jesus and the "woman at the well" is recorded as the longest conversation had by Jesus in the entire Gospels.

They certainly covered a lot of ground. Initially they took a chance on talking at all since Jews and Samaritans didn't mix and to speak to a woman (on her own) could also, in some quarters, be classed as dangerous and ill-advised. Here they are, nonetheless, chatting away and coming to a

deeper understanding of one another. Her story was not simple and her stance was one of taking no risk. The request for a drink of water, though straightforward enough, met with a hostile reaction. She pointed out the obstacle - the lack of a bucket and the depth of the well. He didn't need the bucket and cared less how deep the well was. His purpose in opening conversation was to bring her to a better place, while recognising fully where she stood.

There's a bit of banter about it all. A sort of Ping-Pong exchange that ultimately leads to a powerful moment of recognition - "Come and meet a man who has told me everything I've ever done. I wonder could he be?"

Are we willing, in the coming week, to sit with the Lord and allow him lead us to a deeper recognition of who we are, who He is, more importantly, what we can become together?
