Palm Sunday - 24th March 2013



We begin Holy Week. It is a "seamless garment" of prayer that leads us to the Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday. The prayers begun on Holy Thursday end with the final blessing of Easter Sunday and we are invited to enter as fully as possible into this time of prayer.

Please come along as often as you can during Holy Week, join our parish, diocese and the Global Church in re-telling the Sacred Story of the Lord's Passion, Death and Resurrection. This is more than a story - it is a pattern for living and a call to deeper faith and union with Jesus Christ.

Meet again the reluctant judge who gave into the mob, the man pulled from the crowd to help shoulder the cross, the woman with the towel who washed the face of Jesus, the mother and beloved disciple addressed and united from the Cross, the centurion who went home knowing that he'd witnessed the death of "the son of God", the repentant thief assured a place in Paradise, Joseph of Arimathea who gave a place for the body to be buried. Meet Judas and Peter, the women of Jerusalem and so many more who are this Sacred Story. Your part in the script is central too. Please JOIN one another in sharing the Word.
