YEAR OF PRAYER

This week we focus our Diocesan Prayer on the Parish of Ballaghaderreen. Please pray the Diocesan Prayer whenever possible during the week.

PARISH OF BALLAGHADERREEN

The parish of Castlemore and Kilcoman, (Ballaghaderreen), is the Cathedral parish of the diocese of Achonry. There are four church areas in the parish, each with its own vibrant community, Ballaghaderreen, Brusna, Derrinacantha and Monasteraden. The Cathedral was consecrated and dedicated to St. Nathy and the Annunciation on the 3rd. November 1861. The Church of St. John the Baptist and St. Colman in Derrinacantha was built in 1873, St. Aiden's, Monasteraden was built in 1881 and the Sacred Heart in Brusna was opened 1950. Religious practice has been to the forefront in this community for centuries. In spite of constant harassment, priests continued to minister to the people celebrating Mass in the open air at Mass Rocks, such as the elaborate 'Four Altars' in Creggane, Edmonstown. There is also an Altar beside St. Attracta's well in Clogher, Monasteraden. Three counties meet in the parish, Sligo, Mayo and Roscommon adding to the diversity

of the people and their religious practice.
