Such was the choice for countless men and women who played "Who Wants To Be A Millionaire"!

It seemed simple enough. A question, a limited number of possible answers and the safety net of seeking some assistance with the answer. Very few made it to the million, of course, very few indeed to the higher stakes. Choice is always difficult.

It is such a choice that is put to Solomon in our Old Testament reading. He is, in his dream, offered anything he wants. His answer is the desire to have a discerning heart. How would we handle a choice like this? Offered anything we might want, would we spend so much time trying to decide that life might have passed us by? That seems to be the way .... The task of selecting an item from a supermarket shelf can be daunting - how much more so the questions and decisions of life?

The truth is God wants to give us what we need. There are times though we may not know what we need. Solomon's request for a discerning heart - that can distinguish between good and evil - still has its place. Maybe that's what we pray for in the week ahead.



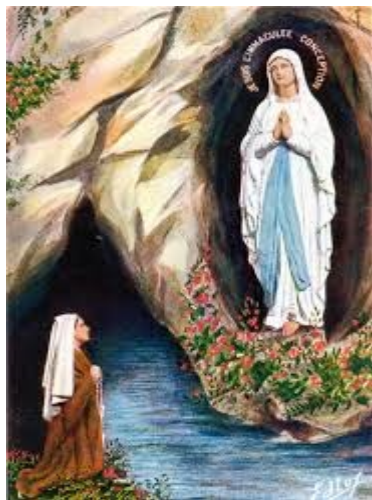
### **PLEASE PRAY FOR**

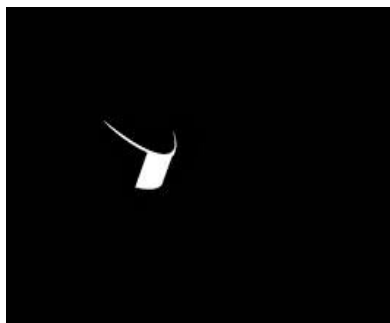
the aim is to use as much Irish as possible. The cost is €20 per child. Booking at Kilmovee Frc.

### **PYLON NEWS**

*(Message from local Action Group)*

Over the last few months a couple of big things have happened, Firstly, Eirgrid have finally conceded that undergrounding is an option this will be a benefit to all concerned landowners who were facing into the prospects of having a 46 meter high pylon on their land along with the associated risks. By no means do we believe this is the option they will choose, and not until the over ground option is scraped will we rest. The second is that your anti-pylon group is now part of a more dynamic and focused group called Western Pylon Pressure (WPP) we will be releasing a more detailed statement in the coming weeks as we believe that the Pylon positions will be announced in a matter of weeks. In the meantime we ask you to continue to lobby your local councillor, TD, Senator or MEP to stop the pylon blight facing our area and decimation of livelihoods and possible health implications.
