***SING A NEW SONG UNTO THE LORD ....***



Last week, I attended the ordination of my classmate, Eamon Martin, as Coadjutor Archbishop of Armagh. The “coadjutor” bit means that he will succeed Cardinal Seán Brady as Archbishop and Primate of All Ireland when Cardinal Brady retires. In the meantime, Eamon will assist Cardinal Brady in the running of the diocese, celebrating the sacraments and heading up the Catholic Church in Ireland. It is quite an undertaking but one he seems well suited to and chosen for. He took as his Episcopal Motto a latin verse from the Psalms that says “Sing a new song unto the Lord”. He spoke around this theme before the final blessing on Sunday last and it’s clear he has the desire to sing and the heart for a new song. He pointed out though that we must remain faithful to the lyrics received and that’s it’s not enough to put catchy words to another tune.

What is all this saying? I believe it’s a call to us all to find this song and, having found it, to sing it with full heart and soul. We hear a lot now about videos “going viral” on YouTube. This means that something small has taken on a life of its own and spread like wildfire so that it’s talked about, shared, tweeted, Facebooked (if there’s such a verb!!) so that as many as possible become aware of and anxious to share.

This is truly the story of our Faith and worship. It’s about a “new song” and the singing with renewed heart of the old song. Are we ready to “go viral”?
