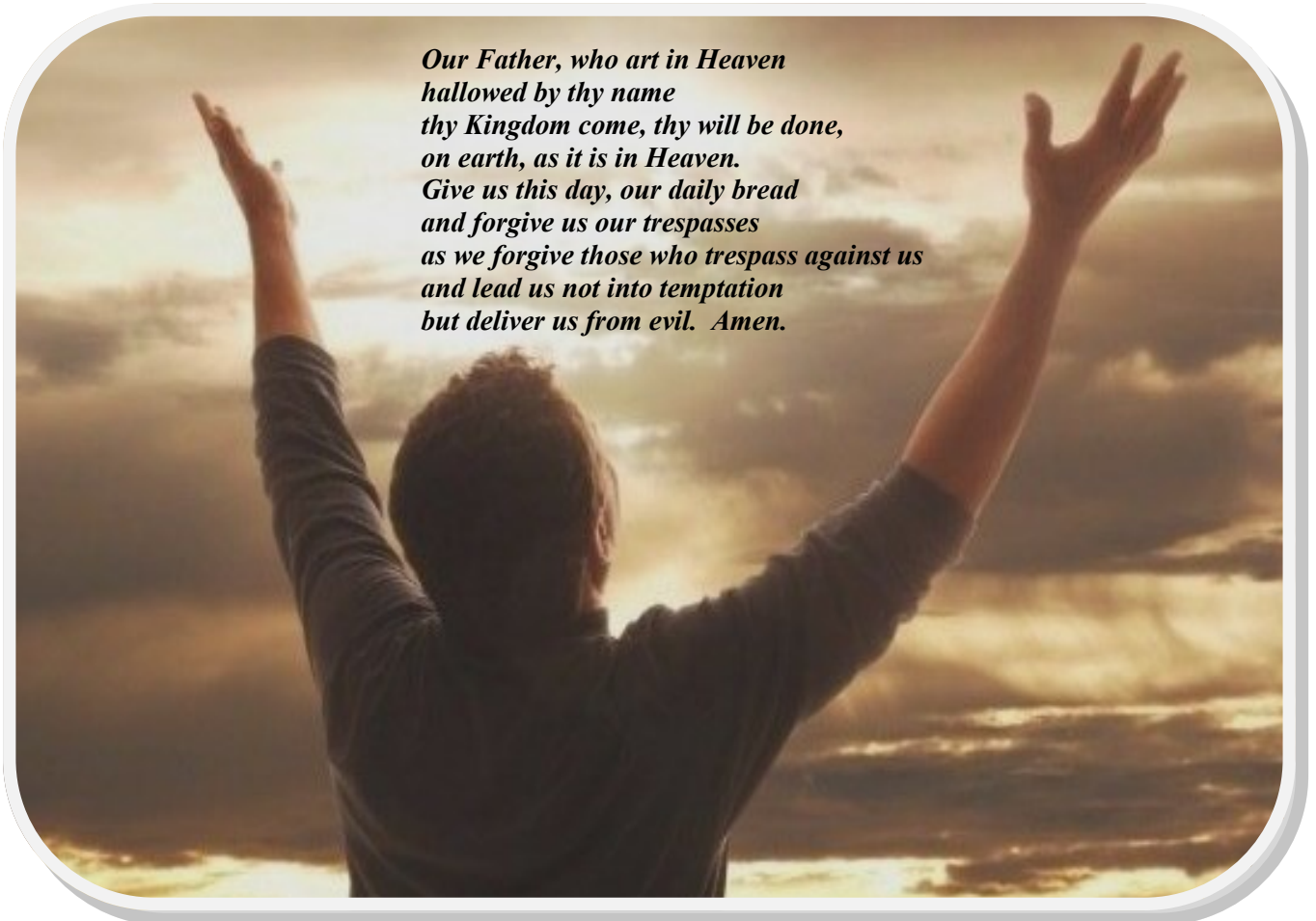
MISSION STATEMENT
