To qualify a person must be in receipt of the Old Age Pension, have a landline or mobile phone and live in the Kilmovee/Urlaur area. Community Alert can seek funding for the provision equipment. Once fitted, the alarm is monitored on a 24 hour basis, seven days a week and the annual cost is €80 which may be instalment paid by annually, quarterly or monthly. 
# LOURDES PILGRIMAGE

You are required to give notification to The State of your intention to marry and if you are asking a priest from outside the country to celebrate your Wedding Mass, he needs to be added to the list of Solemnisers of Marriage. This is an easy process but must be attended to as soon as possible. Check with either priest of the parish for further details. As part Regulations of Diocesan re Safeguarding of Children, all priests assisting at marriages are asked to present an up to date "Celebret" (letter of commendation from their diocese or Religious Order).
