PARISH OF BUNNANADDEN

The parish of Bunnanadden (comprising the ancient parishes of Cloonoghil, Kilturra and Kilshalvey which united in 1767) is a rural parish in south Sligo, with the district of Doocastle situated in Co. Mayo. The parish has two churches. The parish church, built in 1829, is located in the village of Bunnanadden and is dedicated to the Sacred Heart. The church in Killavil was built in 1861 and is dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. There are two National Schools in the parish - Scoil Croí Naofa and Killavil National School. Many thriving community organisations and clubs are centred around the Community Centre (Bunnanadden), the Community Park (Ballinalack), and the Céilí House (Killavil). Traditional Irish music has strong roots in the parish and monuments, dedicated to the memory of former musicians, can be found in many parts of the parish.
