

KILMOVEE/URLAR GWS

The AGM of Kilmovee/Urlaur Group Water Scheme was held on Thursday 20th June in Kilmoyee Community Centre. The water charges for 2013 were adopted. The new rates for domestic volumetric use are as follows. Up to 45 Cubic Metres free. Each Cubic Metre over 45 Cubic Metres will be charged at €0.80. Non domestic users will be charged €0.80 for each Cubic Metre. No free allowance. (One Cubic Metre=220 gallons) A capital contribution charge of €50 per house was approved. This will help to pay necessary repairs such as remedial works for water towers and other necessary on-going repairs. A Special General Meeting was held and approval was granted for the adoption of a new set of rules which embraces all consumers.
