YEAR OF PRAYER remembering PARISH OF COLLOONEY

Collooney (Kilvarnet) is a rural parish in the Diocese of Achonry. The boundaries of the parish date from 1978, when a larger parish called "Ballysadare and Kilvarnet" were divided. The present parish comprises the ancient parish of Kilvarnet and part of the ancient parish Ballysadare. There are two churches in the parish – Church of the Assumption in Collooney, which was consecrated in 1861 and the Church of St. Fechin and St. Lassara in Ballinacarrow, which was dedicated in 1904/1905, situated approximately 5 miles south of Collooney. There are 3 schools in the parish, Mary Immaculate Girls' NS and St. Joseph's Boys' NS in Collooney and St. Fechin's NS, Ballinacarrow. Cloonamahon, which is in the parish, was a former Passionist Monastery, now a Residential Care Home for people with intellectual disability. Fr. Pat Peyton is Parish Priest of Collooney and Fr. Jim Finan, former Parish Priest of Keash is a priest in residence
