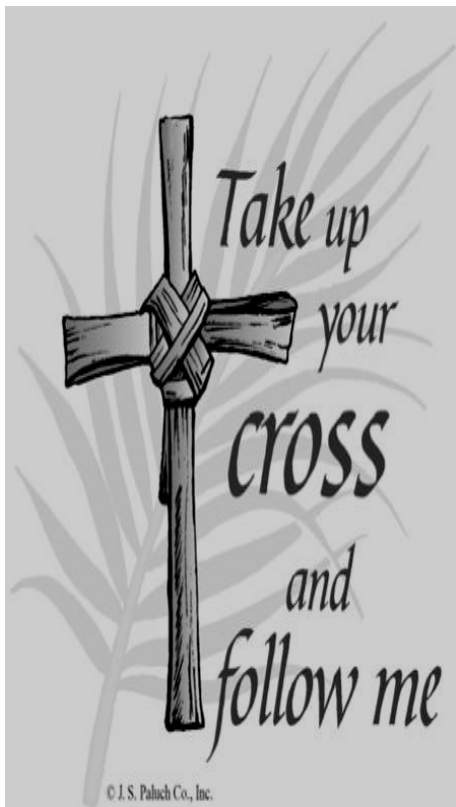

CROSSES TAKEN UP AND CARRIED ...



The Cross is so close to many people. There is scarcely a day its weight is not felt by someone we know or hear about. Most of us too, have known the cutting edge of its weight as it buries itself into our skin, finds the sore spot and leaves its mark.

It comes in many shapes and sizes and is always an unwelcome intruder, scarcely worthy of the title “guest” or “visitor”. Always it seems undeserved, cruel and crushing. The Cross is just that CRUEL.

At times you wonder how people cope with the heaviness of the Crosses laid on their shoulders. Along with the wonder there's an admiration for their strength of character and depth of faith that allows them some degree of peace, acceptance and above all, hope in time of despair.

Where did Jesus find this acceptance and hope? Somehow he found it in people around him; Peter James and John even as they slept in the garden, his mother in the crowd (Fourth Station of The Cross), Simon, Veronica, the “Good Thief” and the Centurion who recognised him. YEAR OF PRAYER 2014 BUNNINADDEN

'Late have I loved you, O Beauty so ancient and so new; late have I loved you! For behold you were within me, and I outside; and I sought you outside and in my ugliness fell upon those lovely things that you had made. You were with me and I was not with you. I was kept from you by those things, yet had they not been in you, they would not have been at all. You called and cried to me and broke open my deafness: and you sent forth your beams and shone upon me and chased away my blindness: you breathed fragrance upon me, and I drew in my breath and do now pant for you: I tasted you, and now hunger and thirst for you: touched me, and I have burned for your peace.' 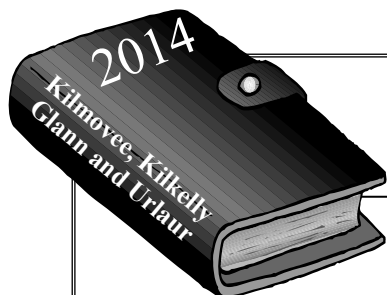
