CENSUS 2016

Census takes place on Sunday April 24th. At present around 4700 enumerators are delivering Census Forms to every home in the country. Following the Census, these people will collect the completed forms. There is a legal obligation on all citizens to complete the Census Form and, in addition to this, the value of the census results is a significant pointer towards the provision of services and future planning. All information gathered is treated in total confidence and used for statistical purposes only. Enumerators will wear high visibility jackets and produce an official Identification Card during the course of their work. Your co-operation with your enumerator is very important and greatly appreciated. Thank you.

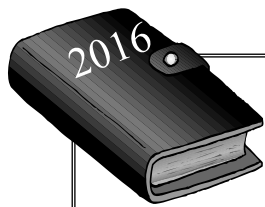
