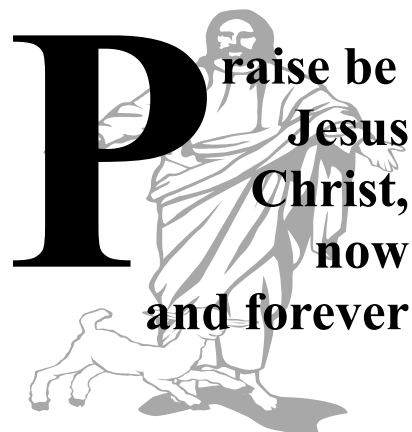
Now, Master, you let your servant go in peace. You have fulfilled your promise.

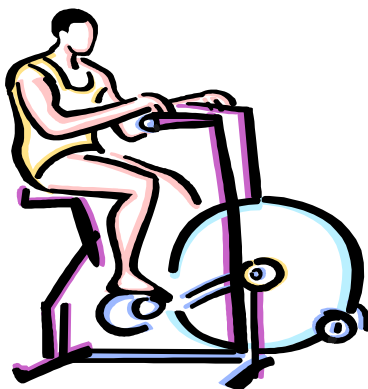
The next meeting of Kilkelly ICA will be held on Tuesday the 12th of February at 8 o'clock in Kilkelly Community Centre. New members are always welcome.
