Please make note of these dates and join us in prayer as we celebrate the yearly liturgy in our parish.

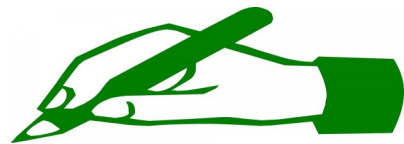


WEDDING BELLS

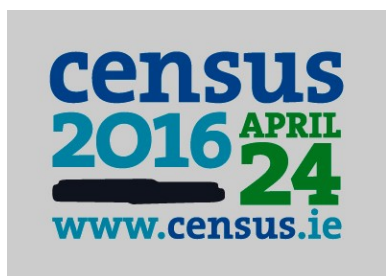
