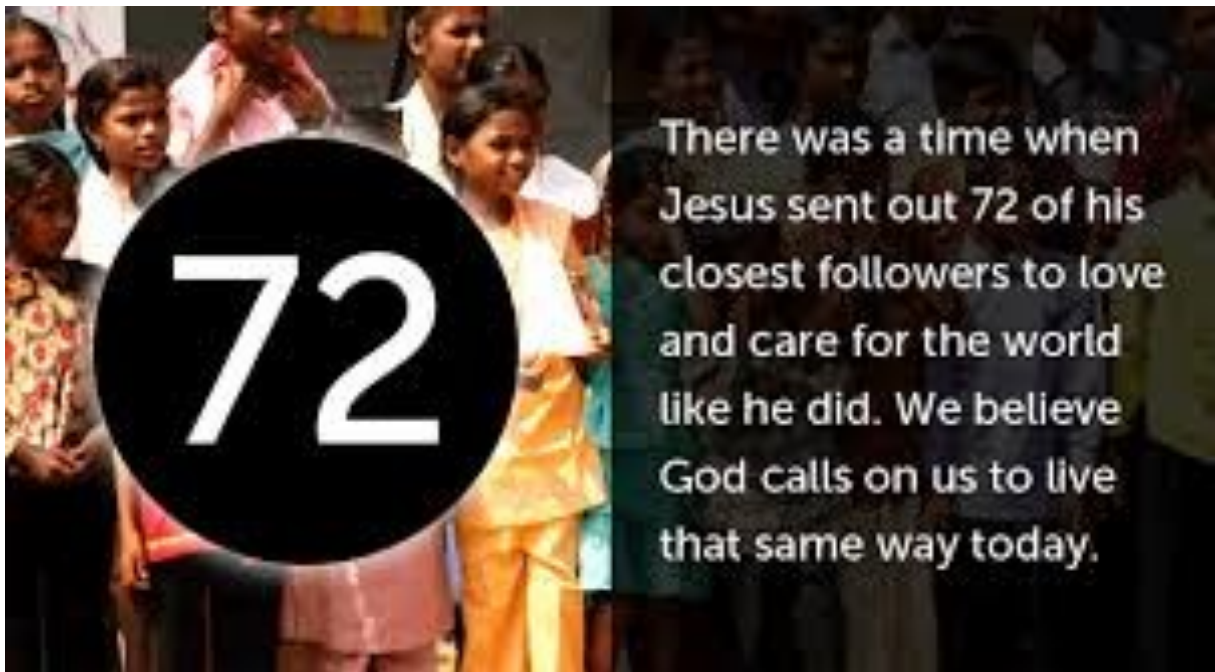


## MISSION STATEMENT

## CHARLESTOWN ARTS CENTRE

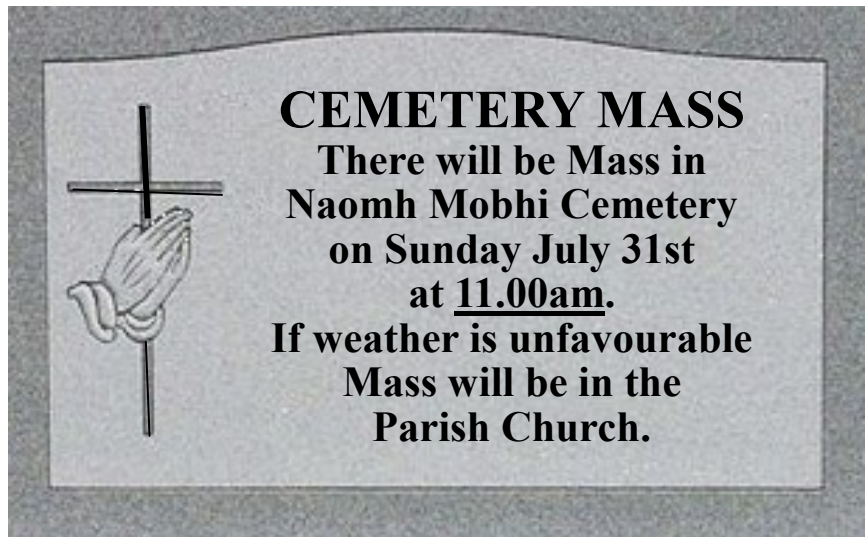

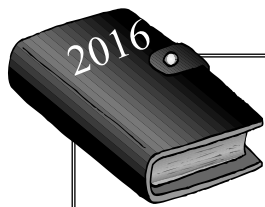
## KNOCK SHRINE

1. Cradle one hand (palm up) over the other.
2. Receive in the Open Palm.
3. Step one side but don't walk away,
4. Take Host from Open Palm with the other hand
5. Place the Host in your mouth before returning to seat.
