MOSES AND THE BURNING BUSH

We are familiar with the story of Moses and the Burning Bush but what does it mean? An internet search gives the following possible explanation. It might be helpful.

Fire is symbolic of:

- God's glory
- A source of illumination
- An indication of power
- A source of cleansing
- A source of warmth and comfort in cold and dark places
- God's wrath against uncleanness

That the bush was not consumed is a sign that:

- That the fire was not sustained by the bush. God's existence doesn't depend on anything nor anyone else.
