MISSION STATEMENT

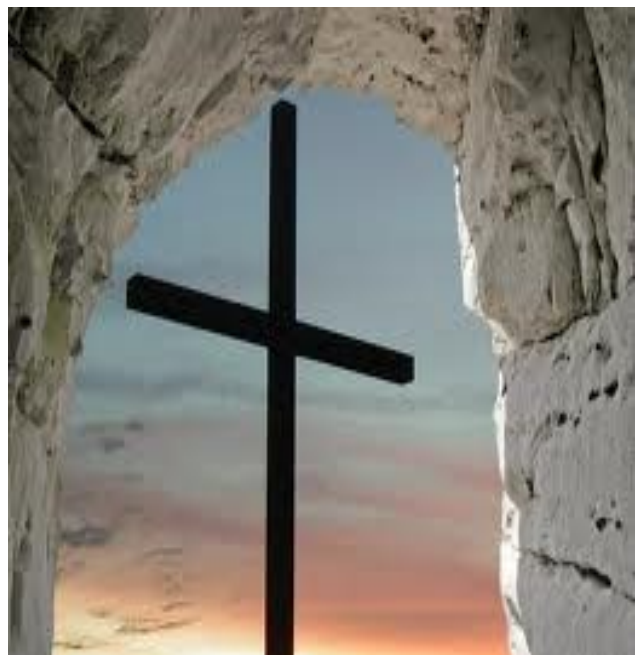
