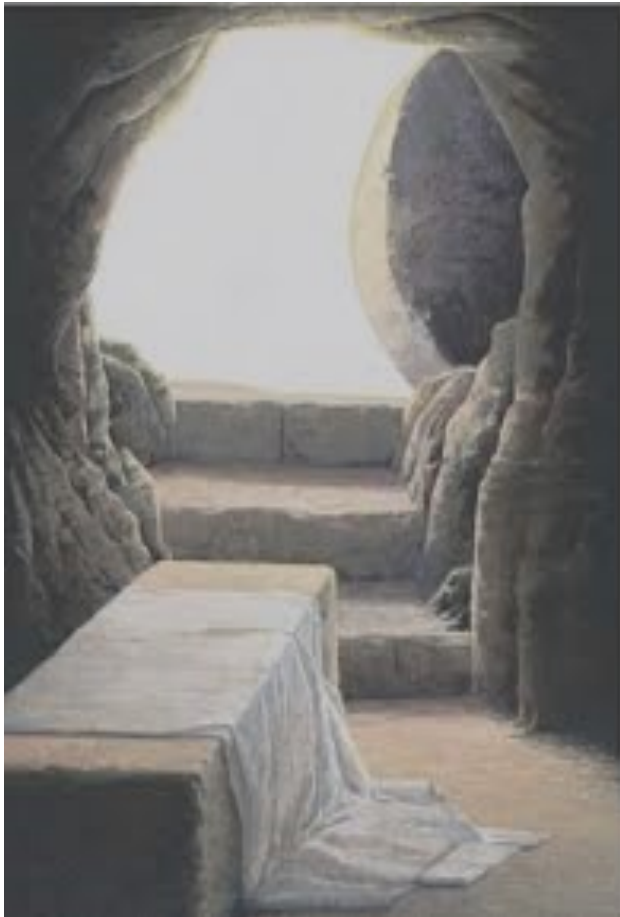


MISSION STATEMENT
