Once fitted, the alarm is monitored on a 24 hour basis, seven days a week and the annual cost is €80 which may be paid by instalment annually, quarterly or monthly. ### **GROUP WATER SCHEME**

The AGM of Kilmovee/Urlaur GWS was held on 24th June. The minutes of the last meeting were read and adopted. The audited accounts were presented by the Accountant and adopted. Water rates are the same as last year up to the 30th September. The rates are €0.80 per CM .Domestic consumers have 45 CM free. There is no free allowance for farms or businesses. A cubic meter is 220 gallons. All metered water must be paid for. Leaking water cisterns and leaking or overflowing water troughs will increase your bill very significantly. Any Board member if requested will show you how to check for leaks using your meter. Please note the scheme is independent of Irish Water. You will receive correspondence from Irish Water in the near future and note it has nothing to do with your scheme.

## **SUMMER SCHOOL**

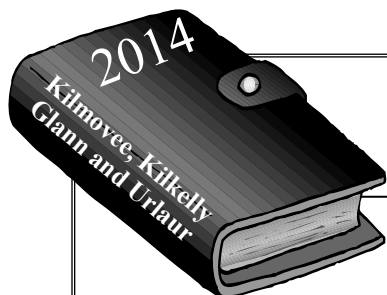
