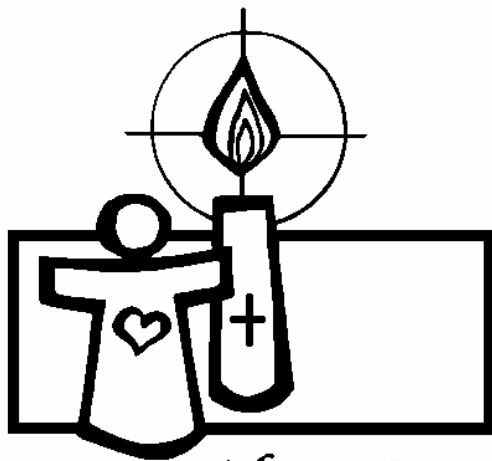


MISSION STATEMENT
