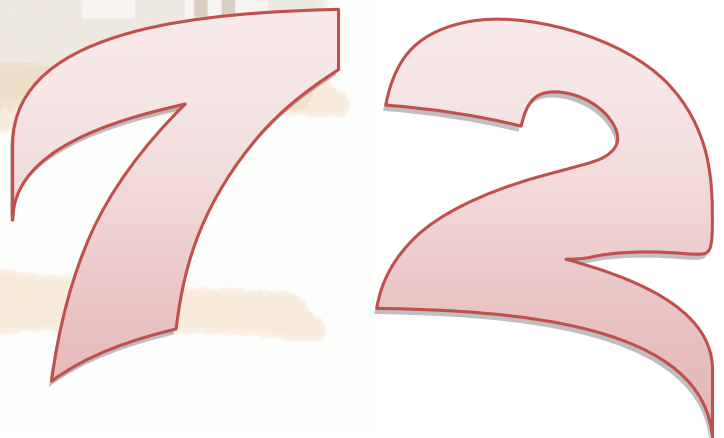


Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time – 7th July 2013

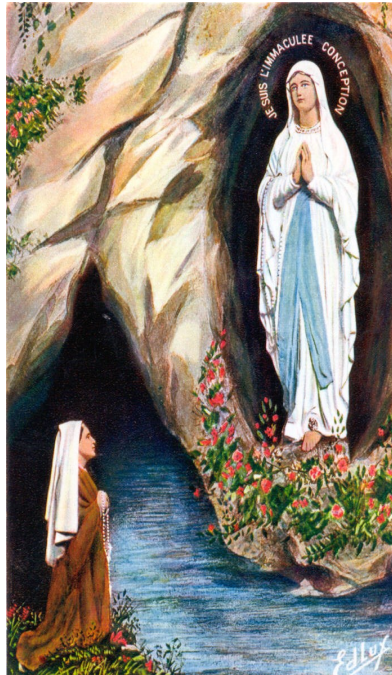

GETTING MARRIED

If you are getting married in the coming year the following might be of helpful. You need to give three month's notice to your parish, to register your intended wedding date with the General Register's Office (www.groireland.ie), to arrange to attend a Pre-Marriage Course - the church approves courses run by ACCORD (www.accord.ie), Esker Monastery, Mount Argus (speak with your local priest before arranging a Pre-Marriage Course). You will need copies of your Baptismal and Confirmation Certificates, to complete a Pre-Nuptial Enquiry Form with the priest of your parish. In selecting music for the church, it is important to choose a musician/singer who is familiar with Church Liturgy and chooses hymns etc from appropriate music for the church. A very useful website you might like to check out is www.gettingmarried.ie Please know that either priest in the parish is happy to assist you in any way possible as you plan for your wedding day.
